November 29 & 30, 2024

The Port Townsend Arts Guild invites you to apply for their Annual Holiday Arts and Crafts Sale to be held in the Port Townsend Community Center (620 Tyler) on **Friday** and **Saturday**, November 29 & 30, 2024, 10am-5pm both days.

We are looking for quality YEAR-ROUND arts and crafts, made by your hands, well designed and thoughtfully displayed. Items assembled from kits, resale, and imports are not acceptable. This is not a Christmas bazaar, but rather a juried arts and crafts sale.

There are two booth types available. 10 X 10 spaces in the lower two levels for \$125 and 6 X 8 spaces in the upper level for \$95. All displays must fit within your allotted space. 6 and 8 foot tables may be available for your use in the upstairs rooms and electricity is also available on both levels. **A \$5 annual membership fee is required if not previously paid.** A 5% commission on sales is collected at the end of the sale to benefit the local food bank.

- Setup begins at 7:00am on Friday. Please be considerate of others by unloading quickly and moving your vehicle before setting up. There are stairs at all entrances to the gym in the lower level. Lower level lobby is wheelchair accessible.
- The lower level gym has some windows but lighting is recommended.
- Do not tape, tack, nail, or staple anything to the walls or columns.
- You can be festive with your display, but it is not required.
- We will have live music and refreshments downstairs. Please contribute a non-messy finger food for the refreshment table. Provided for your customers pleasure and to keep them shopping.
- The rooms are usually marked out on Wednesday evening. **HELPERS** are welcome to begin their setup after this is **FINISHED. Do not show up without contacting us first. No Thanksgiving Day set up.**
- If you are unable to attend, please let us know as soon as possible. We usually have a waitlist. No shows, late arrivals, and early departers are usually not welcome back.
- **\$50 will be deducted from your booth fee if you cancel before October 1st. No refunds after that date.**
- We will return checks if the sale is full **or cash it if you are accepted.** Basic setup info is available on the website and you will be sent up to date info prior to the sale.

To apply, send us four photos of your work and one of a stocked display, either by USPS or email. If you email, please send photos directly. Do not refer to a website. **Mail your application with your check.** If you have participated in a Guild event in the last three years, and make the same things, photos are not needed unless you wish to update for publicity purposes. Photos will not be returned. YOU must make all that you sell. No kits, imports or resale items. If you are new, please describe your work in detail on the application. If you sell recorded music, you must have earphones for your customers. Limits will be set in all media categories for diversity. As important as the search for talent is, we do not lose sight of the need for artists who are cooperative and easy to work with. No amount of talent or ability will compensate for this. Previous participation does not guarantee a space. Applications are accepted until the fair is full. Artists are accepted on a first come-first served basis. Please apply early. Sending application materials in oversize packaging may delay your application due to the size of the post office box.
